F-500 Fire Suppression Agent on a Barn Fire

Dear Mike.

As you know, our fire department has been using F-500 for about four years, with nothing but the best results. However, I just wanted to let you know of an experience we had that shows how effective F-500 can be, in hopes that you share this information with other Fire Departments around the country.

On August 4, 2003 we were called to help another department with a barn fire. When we arrived they were using a Compressed Air Foam System (CAF) and Class A Foam with a 2 ½" attack line, a very expensive set up. We set up with a 1¾" attack right along side of them, using F-500 proportioned at 1% through our standard equipment. The F-500 extinguished the fire almost immediately. You couldn't have scripted a better comparison test of the two agents. The F-500 put the Class A Foam to shame.

It never ceases to amaze me that departments will spend up to \$40,000.00 on Compressed Air Foam (CAF) system, when they could simply buy F-500, use it through standard equipment and outperform Class A foam every time; even when the Foam is being applied using a CAF System, a system specifically designed to enhance the performance of Foam.

Thanks again for introducing us to F-500. I hope that this letter will convince other fire departments to give F-500 a try; because I know that once they try it, they will be sold.
